SHOOT ZONE T&C'S OF ENTRY TO ALL FACILITYS

Shoot Zone Pty Ltd follows guidelines and standards outlined within the FIBA OFFICAL RULES 2022 as well as STATE GOVERNMENT LAWS

Shoot Zone is dedicated to a healthy playing center and environment at all times with strict entry conditions to the venues, programs, and all other "Shoot Zone related activities, at all time to issue the culture and pathways set out are clear and easily maintained.

These entry condition include:

- 1: Respect Shoot Zone Venues, Staff members, Trainers, Coach's and members at all time. The following types of behavior, where repeated or occurring as part of a pattern of behavior, would be considered bullying: verbal abuse including shouting, swearing, teasing, making belittling remarks or persistent unjustified criticism; excluding or isolating a group or person; spreading malicious rumors; or psychological harassment such as intimidation.
- 2: Value and respect the property of Shoot Zone. Swinging on hoops is prohibited at all times, Basketballs or "sport" shoes to be worn on court and work boats, high heals are not allowed to be worn whilst playing on the courts at any time.
- 3. Treat people involved in the game of basketball with courtesy, respect and proper regard for their rights and obligations and in particular, respect the spirit of fair play and non violence.
- 4. Team coaching staff and management should not remain in team changing rooms unnecessarily. Generally, coaching staff and management should only be required in changing rooms for pre-game or post-game meetings between coaches and athletes, or if attendance is otherwise required by an athlete.
- 5. Refrain from any conduct which is; might be reasonably regarded as; or is being investigated for potentially being a breach of the criminal law applicable to the jurisdiction in which you are located at any time.
- 6. Do not denigrate and/or intimidate players, officials, spectators or event organizers.
- 7. Refrain from unnecessary or obvious dissension, displeasure or disapproval with officials' decisions or spectator or player conduct.
- 8. Any anti social behavior or behavior deemed to be "threatening" is unacceptable and will not be tolerated at Shoot Zone.
 9. Any act of vandalism to Shoot zone facilities or equipment will be address with the full force of the law and those/he/she involved will be banned from any Shoot Zone facility.
- 11. The use of drugs, or any illegal substance are not to be bought in to any shoot zone facilities.
- 12. Alcohol is not to be consumed with in Shoot Zone venues at any time
- 13. Treat another person's property with respect and due consideration of its value.
- 14. Respect the law and customs of each area you visit in foreign countries.
- 15. Do not make statements or take part or otherwise participate in demonstrations (whether verbally, in writing or by any act or omission) regarding political, religious or racial matters or any such matters which are prejudicial to or contrary to the objects, purposes or interests of Shoot Zone or which bring Shoot or the squad or team into disrepute.
- 16. Show concern and caution towards sick and injured athletes by: (a) Providing a modified training program where appropriate; (b) Allowing further participation in training and competition only when appropriate; (c) Seeking medical advice when required; and (d) Maintaining the same interest and support towards sick and injured athletes.
- 17. Provide a safe environment for training and facilities and competition by: (a) Ensuring equipment and facilities meet safety standards; and (b) Ensuring equipment, rules and the environment are appropriate for the age and ability of the athletes.
- 18. Behave and encourage behaviour that upholds the highest standards of integrity and dignity. Uphold, and not injure or compromise, the standing and reputation of Shoot Zone.

 19. Not engage in, or encourage, any conduct which is unbecoming of a Shoot Zone representative that brings the game of
- 19. Not engage in, or encourage, any conduct which is unbecoming of a Shoot Zone representative that brings the game of basketball and/or FIBA into disrepute or is otherwise harmful to the interests of basketball and/or Shoot Zone.
- 20. Coaching, training and any Shoot Zone Staff to be a positive role model for basketball and players. Encourage your players to demonstrate the qualities outlined in this Code.

Persons enter shoot zone at their own risk. Each person assumes all risk of any damage or loss (including property damage, personal injury, economic and consequential loss) however it arises at Shoot Zone.
